RED CROSS FIRST AID CLASSES ONLINE!

First aid is the emergency care a sick or injured person gets. In some cases, it may be the only care someone needs, while in others, it may help them until paramedics arrive or they are taken to the hospital. The best way to prepare for these events is to get official first aid training. Charbonneau residents have expressed an interest in this type of training and we are happy to announce it is readily available online!

The Red Cross offers many classes and most are \$35 **unless you are a registered volunteer and then they are free!** Below are links to the site with all the classes for the public, and links to three specific classes.
