## WHO TO CALL IN AN EMERGENCY

## For Emergencies: Call 9-1-1

For non-emergencies, Call: 503-655-8211 (24/7) (Clackamas County Sheriff's Office)

What is the difference between an emergency and a non-emergency?

## When in doubt, always call 9-1-1

Emergency calls may include:

- An incident where life or properties in immediate danger
- An injury requiring immediate medical attention
- A fire (not a controlled burn pile or other controlled fire)
- A crime in progress
- A serious traffic accident
- A violet dog attack of a person (not just running at large)
- A driver dangerously swerving on the road
- Someone playing with guns.

## **MEDICAL OR FIRE EMERGENCIES CALL 9-1-1**

Your first call to report any suspicious vehicles, persons or activity should be to law enforcement, following the guidelines outlined above.

Once law-enforcement has been notified:

- Call the Charbonneau office @ 503-694-2300 to share information about the incident. If after hours, leave a message. **The Community Safety** Coordinator will review all calls.
- If after 5 pm and before 8:30 am, call Corporate Crime Control @ 503-505-3327. If there is an officer on duty and patrolling, they will get the call directly. If off duty, please leave a message so they will stay aware.
